Training Programmes

A total of 13 training programmes conducted (Online/Offline) during the period Jan to March, 2022 on different aspects related to crop production, protection in Agriculture, Horticulture and aspects related to Farm Mechanization, Agril. Extension and Women empowerment through income generation, value addition and nutrition for farmers, farm women, rural youth and extension functionaries of Mahaboobnagar district. 705 trainees were benefitted from these training programmes.



NIPHM Certificate course for insecticide management for Insecticide dealers

YFA-KVK, Madanapuram, Mahabubnagar- I organized the Certificate Course in collaboration with NIPHM in the month of February, Hyderabad and SAMITHI for a period of 12 Weeks, an exclusive training programme for Insecticide Distributors and Dealers to familiarize them with different aspects related to Insecticide Act, rules and subject matter on pest, disease and weed management strategies also covering different insecticides and its classification and many other relevant aspects.



FPO Workshops

YFA-KVK, Madanapuram, Mahabubnagar-I is working with 5 FPOs, as result an two Workshops-"Capacity building training programme was organized for Board of Directors (BODs) and CEOs of FPO by Dr. G. Bhavani (SMS-Agril.Extension) with CSA collaboration for first workshop for three days 05.01.2022 to 07.01.2022 and second one from 14.03.2022 to 16-03.2022 at YFA-KVK campus by joining hands with Centre for Sustainable Agriculture Trust, Hyderabad. In the inaugural session all SMSs and KVK staff took part.



PRA

Farmer and Scientist visits

Field visits: 34 scientists visit to farmers field were made in the duration of three months, 183 farmers were advised on crop production and protection aspects and also in the good agricultural practices respective to the crop.

Farmer visit to KVK: 407 farmers visited KVK to get the information on agriculture, horticulture crop production technologies, on farm mechanization, regarding FPOs activities, value addition and on enterprise developmental activities, availability of seed and other bio inputs and planting material and on many more.

• OFTs and FLDs and Extension activities

A total of 2 activities under each head (OFT and FLD) were initiated during the months of Jan to March besides conducted 33 extension activities by involving 1502 farmers participants

- Seed, Poultry and Planting material produced. 20 plant material produced, and 800 backyard poultry birds reared.
- Mobile advisories sent.
