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## Training Programmes

A total of 26 training programmes conducted (Online/Offline) during the period Oct.-Dec. 2022 on different aspects related to crop production, protection in Agriculture, Horticulture and aspects related to Farm Mechanization, Agril. Extension and Women empowerment through income generation, value addition and nutrition for farmers, farm women, rural youth and extension functionaries of Mahabubnagar district. 1021 trainees were benefitted from these training programmes.













## STRY on Organic farming

STRY (Skill training for Rural Youth) programme organized by KVK to create awareness and importance of Organic farming. It was conducted for continues 6 days in KVK. DHSO, Wanaparthy and ADA, Dept. of Agril. were attended for Inauguration as Chief guests. STRY trainings were conducted on composts and its methods, Green Manure, Bio-Fertilizers and their use in field and Horticulture crops. Followed by field visits. Practically demonstrated Bio-fertilizers seed treatment. Vermiculture, key identification of Vermi worms (Earthworms), vermi compost making technology, explained on Vermi Compost Units (Commercial, Farmers units), Cost: Economics and also explained Management of pests and diseases through Organic inputs, Bio control methods (Parasitoids, Predators) and Natural enemies (Bt, NPV, Bio fungicides) and explained about different certifications and application process in organic farming and export regarding.







## STRY on Orchard Management

YFA-KVK: Conducted STRY skill Training on Orchard Management for 6 days in KVK. DHSO, Wanaparthy and ADA, Dept. of Agril. were attended for Inauguration as Chief guests and addressed all Rural youth about STRY trainings and its importance, impact in agriculture and Horticulture. Explained Precautions for establishing new orchards: site selection including climate, soil and water characters. Layout and marking for planting the orchards: Cleaning, levelling, wind breaks, digging and filling of plants. Visit to KVK orchard, study of different irrigation methods, fertilizer application methods. Potting mixture preparation, bag filling, different types of media, different bag sizes, precautions while establishing nursery, site selection for nursery, soil and water characters, Raised bed Preparation etc







## STRY on Repair and maintenance of Tractors

YFA-KVK, conducted STRY raining on Repair & Maintenance of Tractors in collaboration with department of Agriculture, SAMETI & MANAGE to the rural youth for 6 days. The following topics were covered during training. 1) Introduction to Tractors & Farm Machinery 2) Parts and assembly of Tractor 3) Performance of necessary routine checks and maintenance of Tractors 4) Carry out overhandling & repair of Engine 5) Repair of transmission, Hydraulic & Tractor electrical system 6) Maintain health & safety at the workplace 7) 3 days workshop visits to Mahindra, New Holland & John Deere tractor show rooms 8) Certificate distribution and conclusion with feedback.



**Swachhta Programme (Oct and Dec.):** YFA-KVK oraganized many number of programme under swachhta campaign 2.0 in the October and December months, where in SMSs from KVK created awareness on swachhta, crop residue management, cleaning of villages, demonstrated the technology on waste to wealth, cleaned the office and campus and created awareness and oriented school children on various topics like hygiene and sanitation.

Besides SMS (Agril.Engg.) covered topics like plant protection equipment's, Cost and source of plant protection equipment's, Use and operation of plant protection equipment's and Drone technology and drone mounted sprayers.

## Farmer and Scientist visits

**Field visits:** 36 scientists visit to farmers field were made in the duration of three months, 229 farmers were advised on crop production and protection aspects and also in the good agricultural practices respective to the crop.

**Farmer visit to KVK:** 546 farmers visited KVK to get the information on agriculture, horticulture crop production technologies, on farm mechanization, regarding FPOs activities, value addition and on enterprise developmental activities, availability of seed and other bio inputs and planting material and on many more.
