Total 672 trainees were benefitted from these training programmes.













#### CFLD Field days

**Red gram PRG-176**: YFA-KVK, Mahabubngar -I conducted Farmer's Field day in Red gram Var:PRG:176 at DFI-Nelvidi village of Madanapuram Mandal.Farmer H. Ramulu Explained detail Red gram practices followed and problems faced during cultivation. SMS (Plant protection) explained about variety PRG-176, Pest, Disease and Nutrient management to the farmers. Senior Scientist &Head, SMS (Agri. Engg), SMS(Extension) and Sarpanch took part in the programmae. As part of the field day Farmers along with the SSH & SMS visited the fields of the selected farmers.

DAO (i/c), Gadwal, MAO, Alampur AEOs, PA (soil lab), KVK staff and 38 farmers were participated the programme.
